

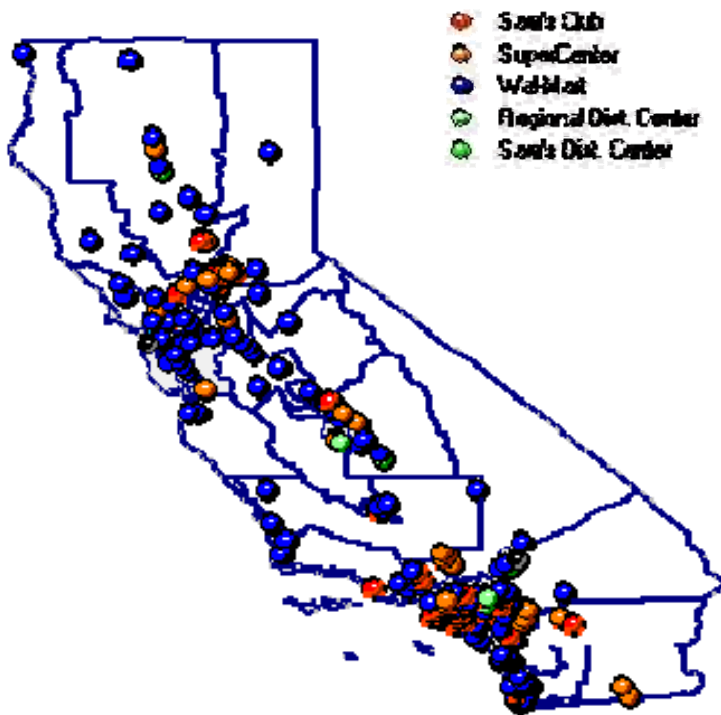

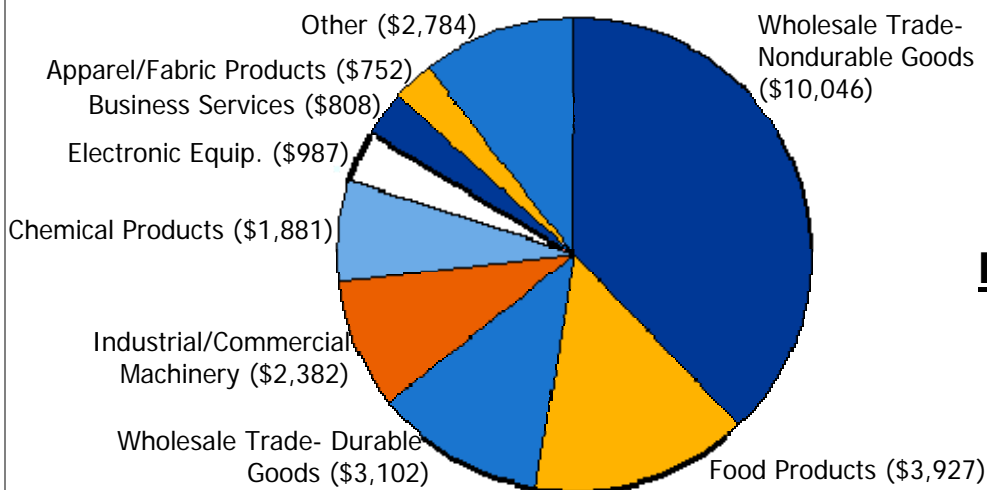

Recent Growth:

Wal-Mart has added 21 stores, hired 12,216 new associates, and sourced from an additional 1,941 in-state suppliers. Additionally, development of an average Wal-Mart Supercenter creates 200 construction jobs. Including expansions, remodeling and new projects, Wal-Mart supported 5,150 new construction jobs in CA in the past 3 years.

Distribution Centers employ on average 2 to 3 times the number of associates as a Wal-Mart Supercenter Store. The largest DC in California is the Porterville Distribution Center with 1,271 associates.
